WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE VILLAGE?




SANS SOUCI ISLAND - LAKE ROSSEAU

Sans Souci Island in the Windermere neighbourhood, and third island from Windermere Village, has a somewhat famous / infamous prior history. In early Muskoka times, a very wealthy gentleman from Hamilton, Senator W. E. Sanford, decided he wanted a fine Muskoka summer cottage instead of his earlier remote hunting lodge. He purchased Sans Souci Island for \$100 in 1884. Mostly hidden by ancient hemlocks, Sanford built his cottage, in grand Victorian style. The cottage, a masterpiece, with 34 rooms, stained glass entrance, billiard room, barber shop, and dark room for photography for himself, family, guests and his two Russian Wolfhounds.



Senator Sanford commissioned a 68 foot steam yacht in 1890, the Naiad, (a water nymph), in the same style as Queen Victoria's yacht, with the Queen's permission, of course. After many years of Sanford cruises, the Naiad was sold to Cameron Peck in 1939, of Lake of Bays, and restored. She then went to Lake Temagami for passenger use and finally destroyed in 1967.



Notable society Sans Souci guests included Governor-General Lord Stanley, giver of the Stanley Cup, in 1890. In 1894, Prime Minister Sir John Thompson visited at a new guest cottage, called Lorelei behind Sans Souci. Another notable, Billy Bishop, visited in 1922 with his float bi-plane to the Sans Souci or Windermere dock.



Very tragically, Senator Sanford drowned off Sans Souci in a rowboat accident in 1899.

In the 1960s, the CBC filmed a spooky children's TV program at Sans Souci called "The Mystery of Lynx Lodge.

Unfortunately, the magnificent Sanford cottage burned in 1969. Currently, the boathouse, coal house for the Naiad, and pump house all remain, now re-modelled and repurposed.
