The week's article of Historical Interest

The Mechanics' Institutes began as voluntary associations of working men seeking self-improvement through education.

Established first in England during the 1820s, these community-based institutes offered evening lectures, lending libraries, and periodical reading rooms. In Canada, the Montreal Mechanics' Institute opening in 1828, and in The York Mechanics' Institute (now Toronto) opened in 1830. The Mechanics' Institute of Windermere was established in 1885. These institutes reflected the 19th-century hope for self-improvement and the growing thirst for reading material. Over time, they also offered lectures on arts and sciences, lent books, and in effect were considered to be the beginning of the public library system.

They expanded across the world.

In 1885, a small group of individuals applied for a Mechanic's Institute for the Village of Windermere. Following is a small portion of the document submitted for application for membership in the organization, with the community members names below (see pg. 2)

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,

We respectfully submit for your consideration the following particulars of a Literary Institution, about to be established at Windermere:

Windermere is pleasantly situated on the eastern shore of Lake Rosseau, four miles from Port Carling, and nine miles from Rosseau Village.

Its fishing and bathing facilities are not surpassed by any other place on the lakes; the surrounding scenery is beautiful and delightful, and the locality is pre-eminently healthful.

One of its peculiar advantages is a never-failing spring which, even in the hottest days of summer, gushes forth cold as iced water, and beautifully clear.

When it comes to understanding who is responsible for the maintenance of "things" around the village, it is good to know exactly what the township does do, and where we, as a community, can "fill in" or help where we can.

Here is the Township list:

- The grass cutting schedule starts at the end of May/beginning of June, and is cut every 7-10 days.
- The beach is cleaned every morning by Muskoka Goose Control who manage the geese. This program runs from April until September.
- The beaches are topped up with sand before summer and off and on after that. Raking is occasional.
 - Rafts and swim lines are installed in June.
- Flowers and planters are NOT managed by the Township. Each community manages their own volunteers with a Communities in Bloom program for some funding.
